

Launching event first joint ERANID call

ERANID or European Research Area Network on Illicit Drugs (www.eranid.eu) is an ERA-NET scheme which consists of 9 organisations in 6 different EU Member States (BE, FR, IT, NL, PT & UK). The network aims to improve cooperation in illicit drug research in order to allow well-founded policy decisions. In this framework, the Network already developed shared priorities for research and we will **launch a first joint research call on illicit drugs in September 2015**.

The topic of the first joint ERANID call is '**Understanding drug use pathways**'. While synchronic realities of drug use and prevalence are well documented in official statistics and studies, the dynamics of onset/stop/reducing/increasing/modifying the set of licit and illicit substances are less documented and will form the core of this call. The launching event of this first joint ERANID call will take place on 22 September 2015 in auditorium II, FIL Meeting Centre, Lisbon, Portugal, from 18:00-21:30.

This event is organised to inform researchers on the first joint ERANID call (eligibility, topic, conditions for participation...). It will also be the opportunity to present other relevant funding possibilities in addiction research (H2020).
