1st call “Understanding drug use pathways”

□ 30 submitted proposals

ERANID received 30 proposals. Following the national eligibility check, 29 proposals were taken forward to the review process

□ 3 selected for funding

A Peer Review Panel was held on March 29th 2016 to make recommendations on those applications suitable for funding. The funders gathered on March 30th 2016 to make a final decision on which proposals to fund. Three projects were successful

1st call “Understanding drug use pathways”

- ❑ In the selected projects 9 European countries participate, some in more than in 1 project

- ❑ Countries are Belgium, France, Italy, Czech Republic, Poland, Sweden, Germany, The United Kingdom and The Netherlands

Submission deadline

October 18th 2016

2nd call ""Society and responses to drug use"

Timeframe

- October 2016: decision on national eligibility
- October, November 2016: remote peer review
- December 2016: peer review panel meeting and decision on funding
- February, March 2017: wrap up meeting ERANID
